

Scientific Diving

Requirements:

- Valid diving certification.
- Current certificate of health.
- Record book with diving experience.
- Passport or other means of photo I.D.
- Certificate demonstrating that the diver has been trained in first-aid during the last two years; this is not mandatory, but it is highly recommended.
- Each researcher must bring their own diving equipment, including a dry suit, BCD, 1st and 2nd stage dive regulators, mask, snorkel, fins, lights, weight belt, ankle weight (if necessary), computer, compass, pressure and depth gauges.

The Huinay Scientific Field Station does not provide complete diving equipment; it only provides tanks and lead weights (not ankle weights).

Basic, minimal equipment is available for rental only in the event of loss or damage of your own items.

There is a small equipment repair shop, but it does not have special tools for specific activities.
